3. Review, discussion and adoption of Resolution 2016-06 approving an amendment to the FY2016-FY2017 UPWP to update planning and financial information;
 - a. Inclusion of FAST ACT – signed into law on 12/4/15-provides long-term funding for surface transportation planning and investment.
 - b. Adjustment to funding tables for FY2017 with relations to funding studies and beginning the development of 2045 MTP in June 2017 instead of June 2016. The allocations for FY2016 and FY2017 remained the same.

 - a. Oakland Road project: is scheduled to be let to contract in the December 2016 letting with the TDOT, SR-13 project being amended above.
 - b. CTS update:
Comprehensive Operations Analysis (COA) will be completed by the end of August by AECOM consultants;

Transfer Center Relocation Study is being handled by Parson Brinkerhoff (PB) consultants and will be completed in November.
 - c. I-24@ Exit 8/SR-237/Rossvie Road: TDOT has completed the widening of SR237 to 5 lanes from I-24 to International Boulevard and the I-24 interchange modification project (There is still dirt work remaining).
 - d. The Park & Ride facility site at Exit 11/SR-76: is under construction and is expected to be completed this fall. The Park & Ride facility site at Exit 8 will remain open until the new site is finished.
